Raising the funds to establish a Bible college in the Dominican Republic.** We have many young people who have graduated and are busy working in the ministry. The next phase of ministry will be training and preparing them in

a trade and for church planting. **2. We are in serious need of a church bus for the work there.** **3. We need to raise the funds for the construction of the church building and staff housing.** Please strive with us in prayer for wisdom and for God's plan to be clear and His provisions for this work forthcoming even when we cannot see how or from where they will come.
