Dear Praying Friends and faithful Supporters,

We have now enjoyed two months back home and in the work God has given us, and so much has happened it seems as though we never left. Though we have found people in their places, we have found that hearts are not. So with renewed vision and fresh zeal from our Lord, we have pushed up our sleeves and bowed on our knees to engage the battle.

In September a mister moved from the big city of Santiago into our rural village. He decided to open a bar right in front, not even 12 feet, of our church. The music is always played with the intent of the entire community hearing so that the people will come to the music to hang out, buy, dance and drink. Because the main party night here is Sunday, this has caused no small conflict. This man has threatened to spray our church with bullets, he claimed that where he came from that Haitian church would already be burned down. He has threatened to call immigration on our people and has used every other device to make the people fearful. Although the local police have come, this man will not hear them. The community magistrate has stood with us, but this man continues. I had an appearance before the judge and magistrate, but the man did not show up and neither did the magistrate! Because we are supposed to live peaceably with all men as much as is possible, we are praying and working to construct our church building on our property. We have a building plan, and we have the workers, but because this project has to be done before the previously scheduled time, we need help raising the funds for construction. The building will cost \$120,000. Please prayerfully consider helping us financially toward this project.
